#### **1 Corinthians 10:11**

Now **all these things** happened unto them for **examples**:  
and they are written for our **admonition\***,  
upon whom the ends of the world are come.

\* Admonition: Counsel, advice, caution, warning or gentle correction

#### **Psalm 40: 6-8** (quoted in Hebrews 10:7)

... in the volume of the book it is written of me  
I delight to do your will, oh my God

## Road to Emmaus

"7 Mile Bible Study"

#### **Luke 24:27**

And beginning with **Moses** and **all the prophets**,  
he expounded unto them in all the scriptures  
the things concerning Himself.

- Jesus explains from the scriptures what the Messiah came to do

#### **Luke 24:44**

These are the words which I spake  
unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled,  
which were written in the law of **Moses**, and in the **prophets**, and in the **psalms**, concerning me.

## Tanakh

- Jewish name for what Christians call the Old Testament
- Is an acronym based on the three sections of the Old Testament
  - T**orah: Instruction/Law of Moses
  - N**evi'im: Prophets
  - K**etuvim: Writings (included the Psalms)
- All portions of the scriptures spoke of Jesus the Messiah

#### **Luke 24:45-46**

Then **opened he their understanding**, that they might understand the scriptures,  
And said unto them, thus it is written, and thus it behooved Christ to suffer, and  
to rise from the dead the third day:

- Despite being with Jesus for months and years, their minds had not been opened to understand

John 14:26

but the Comforter, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and will bring to your remembrance all the things which I have said to you.

- Teach: open their minds to understand the Tanakh
- Remember: Empower them to write the Gospels and accurately share Jesus' teachings

## Old Testament Authentication

- > 165 direct quotes
- > 200 allusions/references
- Always interpreted literally!

### Jesus attributes the Torah to Moses

Matthew 8:4, 19:7-8, 23:2

Mark 1:44, 10:3-4, 7:10

Luke 5:14, 16:19&31, 20:37, 24:27&44

John 3:14, 5:39-46, 6:32, 7:19-23

### Proposition:

Every teaching of Jesus can be found in the Old Testament  
e.g. Good Shepherd

### Jesus Embraces the Law

#### Matthew 5:17-18

Think not that I am come to **destroy** the law or the prophets: I am come not to destroy but to **fulfill**.

For verily I say unto you, until heaven and earth pass, one **jot** or one **tittle** shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

#### Destroy:

Kataluó (καταλύω)

to destroy, overthrow, to unyoke

Kata (κατά)

bring down exactly, completely; be against

Luó (λύω)

Loose (unleash); let go; release (unbind) so something no longer holds together

#### Fulfilled:

Pléroó (πληρώω)

fill to individual capacity to the extent it is appropriate

plérés (πλήρης)

full, abounding in, complete, completely occupied with

Adjective: *full*; used of being *full* of the presence of the Lord (His provisions)

which is the definition of a *full* life

Being "*full*" brings God's *wisdom, grace and power*

## Jot and Tittle

Jot:

Yod (י)

Smallest letter in the Hebrew alphabet

Title:

Small decorative curl on a letter

## When a Jot Mattered Greatly

### Matthew 22: 41-46

<sup>41</sup> Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question: <sup>42</sup> “What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He?” They said to Him, “*The son of David.*” <sup>43</sup> He said to them, “Then how does David in the Spirit call Him ‘**Lord**,’ saying,

<sup>44</sup> ‘The **LORD** (Yehovah) said to my **Lord** (adonai),

“Sit at My right hand,

Until I put Your enemies beneath Your feet”?”

<sup>45</sup> If David then calls Him ‘**Lord**,’ (Kurios) how is He his son?” <sup>46</sup> No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question.

Yehovah (יהוה):

Proper name of God, the father

Adonai (אדני):

Master

Kurios (κύριος):

Master

Owner, a person exercising *absolute ownership rights*

The yod added to adonai changes the meaning from "lord" to "my lord"

This possessive form is crucial Jesus argument that

Messiah was of the lineage of David

but was also the Son of God

and therefore David's LORD!

## Conclusion:

All 66 books of the Bible are accurate, authoritative and applicable to our lives today

A proper understanding of the Bible is necessary to fulfill the great commandments of Jesus  
(Matthew 22:36-40/Mark 12:28-31/Luke 10:25-28)
